APPLYING THE BUSINESS VOICE

As Focal Point for the PSD, GBCHealth manages the PSD Advisory Group, a coalition of 17 companies that bring the business voice and perspective to the Global Fund Board and other Global Fund committees.

The PSD currently serves on four Global Fund committees and working groups, focusing on audit and ethics, finance and operational performance, market dynamics and a special initiative to deliver more affordable anti-malaria drugs.

Dr. Brian Brink of Anglo American plc and Ms. Renuka Gadde of BD (Becton, Dickinson and Company) currently lead the Advisory Group. The larger PSD network includes over 100 companies.

SHAPING POLICY, BUILDING RELATIONSHIPS

Members of the PSD Advisory Group play a critical role in shaping Global Fund policies and strategies so that they are more effective and transparent.

Through Global Fund Board Meetings, delegation members get face-time with some of the leading decision-makers in global health—including heads of major aid agencies and foundations, Ministers of Health and Global Fund senior leaders.

GBCHealth works one-on-one with Advisory Group members, providing guidance on how to strengthen partnerships with the Global Fund and insights on potential entry points for collaboration.
